



VILLAGE OF CHATHAM RECYCLING PROGRAM

1. Who can participate? Any Village residents or businesses in the Village limits.
 2. Pick Up Day: Mondays for Chatham Disposal customers east of Route 4 & Thursdays for customers west of Route 4. All Lake Area customers on Wednesday (if holiday falls on your pick-up day, pick-up will be the next day).
 3. Recyclables to be sorted preferably in brown paper grocery sacks:
 - Plastics (must have the #1 or #2)
 - Metal (aluminum, tin, or bimal)
 - Newspapers (must be dry), junk mail, chipboard (like cereal boxes)
 - No plastic bottles that contained any type of motor oil.
 - No plastic containers where the mouth is wider than the base. This includes items such as butter tubs, and other plastic containers.
 - No plastic containers that held hazardous chemicals, such as some house hold cleaners.
 - Lids, or caps, except metal lids can go in metal collection.
 - All food must be rinsed from jars, bottles, or cans.
 - Place recyclables in large, blue or tan recycle containers and place at curb-side.
 4. How can we get a recycling container? The Village has purchased the bins to help people start the program and these are available for a one time non-refundable rental fee of \$5.00 per bin. The recycle bins are Village property and should be passed on to the next occupant or returned to the Village if you move.
 5. Any overflow can be placed in brown paper bags and placed around the recycle container.
