AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR ALL NECESSARY EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1,1968 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1969.

FOR THAT WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, has prepared a Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and, through the Village Clerk of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, has made the same conveniently available to public inspection prior to final action thereon, according to law, and,

Now, Therefore Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Illinois:

SECTION 1. That the following Budget and Appropriation containing the estimate of the revenue and expenditures, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Appropriation Ordinance, making the necessary appropriations for all necessary expenditures of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1968 and ending April 30, 1969.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I. That exclusive of any and all amounts hereinafter levied for the payment of the principal and interest upon the outstanding bonded indebtedness of said Village and exclusive also of any and all taxes authorized by acts which by their terms provided that such taxes ahall be in addition to taxes for general purposes, the sum of Thirty-five thousand three hundred twenty-one and no/100 dollars (\$35,321.00) is hereby levied and assessed for the fiscal year ending the 30th day of April, 1969, for general corporate purposes upon all property subject to taxation within said Village of Chatham, at the full, fair cash value, as the same is equalized and assessed by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois for State and County purposes, in the following amounts and for the particular objects and purposes hereinbefore specified in the aforesaid appropriation ordinance, and therein identified by corresponding appropriation numbers and items as follows:

A. For the current expenses and capital outlays of the Administrative Departments the sum of Ten thousand sixty dollars(\$10.060.00) is hereby levied and assessed for the several purposes specified in the said appropriation ordinance and therein identified by corresponding appropriation numbers and items as follows:

For the current expenses and capital outlays of the Street Department the sum of Eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.00) is hereby levied and assessed for the several purposes specified in the said appropriation ordinance and therein identified by corresponding appropriation numbers and items as follows:

For the current expenses and capital outlays of the Police Department, the sum of Nine thousand five hundred seventy-five and no/100 Dollars (\$9,575.00) is hereby levied and assessed for the several purposes specified in the said appropriation ordinance and therein identified by corresponding appropriation numbers and items as follows:
 - 12. For the Police Department

SECTION II. There is hereby levied and assessed for Road and Bridge Purposes for the fiscal year ending the 30th day of April, 1969, in addition to all other taxes authorized by law to be levied and collected within the Village of Chatham and in addition to the maximum of thetaxes authorized by Section 1 of Article 16 of the Revised Cities and Village Act, the sum of Two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) upon all property subject to taxation within the Village, at the full, fair cash value of the same as equalized and assessed by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois for State and County purposes.

13. For Roads and Bridges

SECTION III. The Village Clerk of the said Village of Chatham shall file with the County Clerk and the County Treasurer of Sangamon County, and State of Illinois, a certified copy of the ordinance and said County Clerk shall ascertain the rate per centum which, upon the total value of all property subject to taxation within said Village of Chatham, at the full, fair cash value as the same is assessed and equalized by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois, for State and County purposes for the current fiscal year, will produce the net amounts herein

levied and ordered, certified, and he shall extend the tax upon the tax books of the Collector of State and County Taxes within said Village as provided by law.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force within the time provided by law from and after its passage, signing and recording.

SECTION V. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
