

ORDINANCE NO. 77-11

ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO AN AUDIT OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHATHAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 1977

WHEREAS the Village of Chatham is in need of professional accounting services to perform an audit of the various village funds for the year ended April 30, 1977; and

WHEREAS the accounting firm of Ernst & Ernst can provide these services through competent professional personnel;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the accounting firm of Ernst & Ernst in Springfield, Illinois, is hereby retained for the purpose of providing an audit of the various village funds for the fiscal year ending April 30, 1977 under the terms outlined in the correspondence from that firm to the village President, Mr. John Whitney.

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
