

ORDINANCE NO. 77-18

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, three-fourths (3/4) of the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham are of the opinion that certain personal property, namely;

(1) 1973 Dodge Polara, brown, formally used as a police car; and

(1) 1973 Dodge Polara, beige, formally used as a police car;

are no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes 1975, Chapter 24, Paragraph 11-76-4, provides for the procedure to be followed in the sale of said property;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS that the Mayor of the Village of Chatham is hereby authorized to sell the aformentioned personal property in either or both of the following manners:

(a) By advertising their availability for sale in a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Chatham and County of Sangamon; and

(b) Mailing solicitations for bids on said items of personal property to auto salvage companies or auto dealers in the general vicinity of the Village of Chatham.


Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall


