ORDINANCE NO. 77-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67-5 WHICH ESTABLISHED REGULATIONS FOR SUBDIVISIONS, ETC.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 67-5 provided in Section XIV that any subdivider who violated the provisions of that Ordinance would be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof would be fined in a sum not to exceed Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, said penalty provision is not realistic;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEES, constituting the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That Ordinance 67-5 is amended as follows:

SECTION XIV PENALTY


Any subdivider who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed ~~\$50.00~~ One Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars and any subdivider who is found guilty of repeated violations of this Ordinance or wilful disregard of its provisions shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars. *For each violation*

Section 2. This Ordinance shall go into effect thirty (30) days after its passage and publication according to law and it is so ordered by the necessary vote of at least the majority of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance.


