

ORDINANCE NO. 77-25

ORDINANCE RELATING TO WATER TAP FEE

WHEREAS, the expenses incurred by the Chatham Water Department for providing water service have increased considerably because of the increase in costs of labor and materials; and


WHEREAS, the present water tap fee of Two Hundred and 00/100 (\$200.00) Dollars per tap is inadequate to meet the costs of water service presently being borne by the Chatham Water Department.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The water tap charge by the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM shall be Three Hundred and 00/100 (\$300.00) Dollars for each tap.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
