

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 73-10 RELATING
TO DEALERS IN ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS THAT ORDINANCE
73-10 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.


"Section 13. Closing hours.) It shall be unlaw-
ful for the holder of a license, regardless of classification,
to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in
the Village on week days between the hours of 12:00 midnight
and 8:00 a.m. It shall be unlawful for a holder of a license
to sell or offer for sale any alcoholic liquor in the Village
on Sundays between the hours of 12:00 midnight on Saturday
and 12:00 midnight on Sunday. All customers shall vacate
the premises by 12:30 a.m. The provisions of this Section
shall not apply on January 1 of any year when the holders
of a license, regardless of classification, shall be permitted
to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor
in the Village until the hour of 1:00 a.m."

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall
be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval
and publication as provided by law.
