

ORDINANCE NO. 78-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 73-10, AS AMENDED,
RELATING TO DEALERS IN ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS THAT ORDINANCE 73-10, AS AMENDED, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "Section 13. Closing hours.) It shall be unlawful for the holder of any license issued under this Ordinance 73-10 and all amendments thereto, regardless of classification, to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the Village between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. It shall be unlawful for a holder of any license issued under this Ordinance 73-10 and all amendments thereto to sell or offer for sale any alcoholic liquor in the Village on Sundays, except between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.. The Licensee shall cause all customers to vacate the licensed premises within one-half hour after the time at which sales of alcoholic liquor are required by this Ordinance, as amended, to be terminated, and shall not permit the consumption of alcoholic liquor by any person on such licensed premises after such time as customers are required to vacate and before such time as the licensee may next commence sales under this Ordinance. The provisions of this Section shall not apply on January 1 of any year when the holders of a license, regardless of classification, shall be permitted to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the Village until the hour of 1:00 a.m."

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be

in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval
and publication as provided by law.
