

ORDINANCE NO. 79-9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF CONSULTANTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF A STUDY OF RATES CHARGED CUSTOMERS OF THE VILLAGE ELECTRIC SYSTEM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village find it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interest of the Village to retain professional consultants for the purpose of examining the need for the construction of necessary additions and improvements to the Village electrical distribution system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:


Section 1. The President is hereby authorized to retain the firm of C. H. Guernsey and Company of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for the purposes of a) conducting a study of the rates charged customers of the municipal electric distribution system, to make recommendations for changes as may be expedient and necessary and b) for the further purpose of conducting a study of the sufficiency of the present municipal electric distribution system, to make recommendations for improvements thereto, including but not limited to recommendation for construction and expansion of the system.

Section 2. The sum of Nine Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$9,000.00) is hereby appropriated for payment for the services authorized in Section 1 of this Ordinance to be paid upon completion of such services and rendition of statement therefore.


