

ORDINANCE NO. 79-39

AN ORDINANCE CREATING, ESTABLISHING  
AND PROVIDING FOR A ZONING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham desires to undertake comprehensive revision of its Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map and has retained a planner to prepare a text of a new Zoning Ordinance and Map pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the Village is required to provide for a Zoning Commission with the duty of recommending the boundary of districts and appropriate regulations to be enforced therein; and

WHEREAS, such Commission shall be appointed by the President of the Village subject to confirmation by the Village Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A Zoning Commission with the duty of recommending the boundaries of districts and appropriate regulations to be enforced therein be and the same hereby is established.

Section 2. The said Commission shall prepare a tentative report and a proposed Zoning Ordinance for the entire Village and hold a hearing thereon after having published notice of such hearing as is required by law.

Section 3. Said Commission shall cause to be prepared a final report and submit a proposed Ordinance for the entire Village to the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham.

Section 4. The Zoning Commission created hereby shall cease to exist upon the adoption by the Village of Chatham of a Zoning Ordinance and Map for the entire Village.

Section 5. The following persons are hereby appointed to and shall constitute the Zoning Commission of the Village of Chatham:

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
