

ORDINANCE NO. 81-1

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The annual salaries of elected officers of the Village of Chatham are established as follows:

A. For the President and for the Village Clerk, at the rate of Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars per year for each of the two (2) years after the effective date of this Ordinance and thereafter at the rate of Four Thousand Eight Hundred (\$4,800.00) Dollars per year.

B. For Trustees, at the rate of Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2,400.00) Dollars per year for each of the two (2) years after the effective date of this Ordinance and thereafter at the rate of Three Thousand Six Hundred (\$3,600.00) Dollars per year.

Such annual salaries shall be paid in equal monthly installments commencing ^{May 1, 1981.} ~~on the anniversary date of the term of office.~~


Section 2: All ordinances, resolutions and parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.

Section 3: The provisions of this Ordinance are separable, and an adjudication that any provision is invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and approval as provided by law.
