

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL  
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM

WHEREAS, in the opinion of at least three-fourths of the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Chatham to retain the personal property described as a set of tool boxes now owned by it; and

WHEREAS, Dave Bouhds, 50 Merlin Drive, Rochester, Illinois the highest and best bid for such personal property for the sum of Seventy-five (\$75) Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:


Section 1: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, Ill. Rev. Stat., Chapter 24, Section 11-76-4, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham find that the personal property described as a set of tool boxes, now owned by the Village of Chatham, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Chatham and the best interest of the Village of Chatham will be served by its sale.

Section 2: Pursuant to said Section 11-76-4, the President of the Board of Trustees be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to sell the personal property described as one set of tool boxes, now owned by the Village of Chatham to Dave Douhds, 50 Merlin Drive, Rochester, Illinois for the sum of Seventy-five (\$75) Dollars.


Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by at least three-fourths of all the corporate authorities, and approval in the manner provided by law.
