ORDINANCE NO. 89-47

WHEREAS, bids or proposals have been sought and obtained from various sellers of computer equipment for a computer system for the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have reviewed the various bids and proposals received;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, that:

Section 1. The offer to sell a computer system, as made by MENTOR, of Lexington, Kentucky, is accepted, and the President and Clerk are authorized to execute a contract with such seller, to purchase such system for a price not to exceed \$87,447.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published twice within thirty days of November 1, 1989, in the State Journal and Register and shall become effective 60 days after its second publication.
