ORDINANCE NO. 89-48

Be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Illinois, that:

Section 1. The offer to sell certain realty, commonly known as the Chatham train depot, as described on the attached plat of survey by John Reynolds Jr., by Michael Scully and Nanchen Scully, as sellers, to the Village of Chatham, for the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000.00) is hereby accepted, and the President and Clerk are authorized to sign a contract reciting those and other consistent terms, and to fulfill such contract.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published twice within thirty days of November 1, 1989, in the State Journal and Register and shall become effective 60 days after its second publication.
