

ORDINANCE NO. 90- 37

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE BUILDING  
CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 90-12

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF  
CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Section 1 of Ordinance Number 90-12, passed and approved on March 27,  
1990, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There is hereby created a Chatham Building Code Advisory Commission, which shall consist of a Chairperson and six Commissioners appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees. All seven members of the Commission shall be persons who by occupation, training, or experience have knowledge of building codes or the construction trades. All such persons shall also meet the qualifications for office established by the Illinois Municipal Code, except that they need not be members of the Village of Chatham. All members shall serve for a term to and including January 31, 1991, whereupon the Commission shall be abolished. Members shall serve without compensation. The Village President and the Chairman of the Planning and Zoning Committee of the Village Board shall be ex officio, non-voting members of the Commission."

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance is effective immediately.
