
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE EXPENDITURES PENDING
ADOPTION OF ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.


WHEREAS, The appropriation ordinance for fiscal year May 1, 1992, to April 30, 1993 has not as yet been enacted by the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, pending the passage of such annual appropriation ordinance, the corporate authorities of the Village of Chatham have authority to and may make any necessary expenditures upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding fiscal year as provided in Section 8-1-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Pending the passage of the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year May 1, 1992, to April 30, 1993, heads of departments or other agencies of the Village be and they hereby are authorized, beginning May 1, 1992, to make necessary expenditures for the support thereof upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding fiscal year (May 1, 1991 to April 1, 1992.)

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
