

Ordinance No. 92-19

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MOTOR FUEL
TAX REIMBURSEMENT ACCOUNT FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date of this
Ordinance, it shall be the policy of the Village of Chatham that
all funds contained in the Motor Fuel Tax Reimbursement Account
of the General Fund of the Village of Chatham shall be earmarked
for expenditure on street purposes only.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective immediately.
