SECTION 1: That Vandenberg Concrete is hereby authorized to precede with the sidewalk and drainage project on Walnut Street and Illinois Route 4.



As indicated during your recent phone discussion with Jay Jessen, we have taken bids (third time) on the above mentioned project and have received numbers that are closer to our estimates.


We would like to pursue the work and with your authorization, we will go ahead and contract with Vandenberg Concrete to complete the work. (Start when weather permits.)


Your final total would be 0.50 X 6,154 plus \$4,538.00 totalling \$7,615.00. This can be reimbursed when the project is completed.
