AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE BID
FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO TRUCKS

WHEREAS, on June 22, 1994 the Village of Chatham sought bids for two small utility pick-up trucks; and


WHEREAS, on July 8, 1994 the attached bid was opened and the lowest responsible bidder identified; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 1994 the Public Works Committee met to review the bids, and is recommending the bid from Landmark Ford for \$9,051.00 each, for a total of \$18,102.00 to be equally divided between the Electric and Water Funds.



Trucks will be used by meter readers and should be the basic S-10 Ranger-type truck.
