AN ORDINANCE RETAINING RAPPS ENGINEERING FOR CERTAIN CONSULTING ENGINEERING WORK FOR THE VILLAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:


**SECTION 1:** The engineering firm, RAPPS Engineering & Applied Science is hereby retained as a consulting engineering firm for the Village of Chatham, to work on subdivision review projects as determined by the Village Administrator of the Village, or in the absence of the Village Administrator, by the Zoning Administrator of the Village.

**SECTION 2:** The work to be performed by RAPPS Engineering shall be performed pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in a "Agreement for Consultant Services" attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Village Administrator is authorized and directed to sign said Agreement on behalf of the Village. The Clerk is authorized and directed to attest said Agreement on behalf of the Village. The proper officers of the Village are authorized and directed to implement said Agreement on behalf of the Village.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.

EXHIBIT A

AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

This is an AGREEMENT between the village of Chatham, 116 East Mulberry, Chatham, Illinois 62629, hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE" and RAPPS Engineering & Applied Science, 821 Durkin Drive, Springfield, Illinois 62791-7349, hereinafter referred to as the "CONSULTANT".

The VILLAGE proposes to engage the Consultant to furnish certain professional services in connection with the engineering plan review. The proposed plan review involves engineering drawings for the development of the subdivisions in Chatham, which work is hereinafter referred to as the "PROJECT".

The VILLAGE has authority to engage such services, and the CONSULTANT represents that he/she is in compliance with Illinois Statutes relating to professional registration of individuals and corporate practice, if a corporation, for rendering such services.

The CONSULTANT, in signing this AGREEMENT, certifies that he/she has no financial or other interests in the outcome of this project.

Under penalties of perjury, the CONSULTANT certifies that \_\_\_\_\_ is their correct Federal Taxpayer Identification Number and they are doing business as a Corporation



- 1.0 The parties hereby certify that there was compliance with the provisions of the 1994 Land Subdivision Ordinance of the Village of Chatham and the State of Illinois's Architectural, engineering and Land Surveying Qualifications Based Selection Act, Chapter 30 ILCS 53.5/1 et seq., in the procurement of the services covered by this Agreement.
- 2.0 Scope of Work - The CONSULTANT shall complete the following work on the PROJECT.  
Engineering services are required for the Plan Review of the
- a) Location and Sketch Maps
  - b) Preliminary Plan
  - c) Construction Plan
  - d) Construction and Bonding Public Improvements
  - e) Final Plat
  - i) Design Standards and Specifications
  - g) Construction Inspection
- 3.0 Project Schedule - The CONSULTANT shall commence work within two calendar days after date of Authority to Proceed. CONSULTANT shall complete the Plan Review and deliver to the VILLAGE in accordance with the 1994 Land Subdivision Ordinance of the Village of Chatham.
- 4.0 Prime Compensation - The VILLAGE agrees to pay the CONSULTANT for the Work Specified in the AGREEMENT at the specific hourly rates for each class of employee, as agreed to by the Village Administrator and the CONSULTANT, for the actual time the CONSULTANT directly utilizes each such employee on the WORK plus the CONSULTANT'S actual expenses for transportation and subsistence to the WORK.
