

ORDINANCE NO. 98-15

AN PERTAINING TO VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-12

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees at it's regular meeting on February 10, 1998 passed an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Pertaining to Village Employment" to hire four employees, one of which was Mike McCarthy; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 1998 Mr. McCarthy accepted the position and then declined the position on February 18, 1998.


WHEREAS, the Administrative Committee has reviewed the staff recommendations and is affirmatively recommending the following persons:

Public Works Maintainer (Water Department) - Joe Gragg

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Joe Gragg shall be employed by the Village on a full time basis. Paid at an hourly rate of \$15.00, distributed 90% from the Water & Sewer Fund and 10% from the General Fund. In compliance with the Village of Chatham Personnel Manual there shall be a six month probation period with a salary increase of not more the \$.50 per hour. Date of employment shall be determined by the Administrator.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
