

ORDINANCE 98-67

AN ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO VILLAGE EMPLOYEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chris Jones, who is a part-time dispatcher, shall be employed by the Village of Chatham as a Dispatcher on a full time basis at an hourly rate of \$8.826 per hour to be paid from the Electric, General and Water funds.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval as provided by law.


