WHEREAS, the State of Illinois sought and obtained bids for Police squad vehicles for model year 2001; and


WHEREAS, the Village appropriated sufficient funds in the annual Appropriation Ordinance to purchase the equipment bid.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.

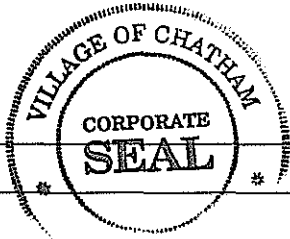


