ORDINANCE 01 - 62

AN ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the position of Recycling Coordinator is currently vacant; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Committee of the Village Board is recommending the position be filled by Vicky Berberich.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Vicky L. Berberich shall be employed as the Recycling Coordinator, a part-time position, to be paid \$1,000 annually, distributed from the General Fund.

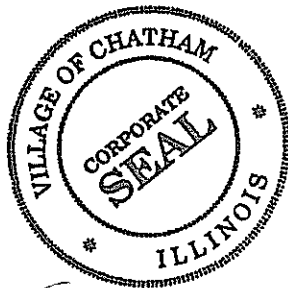
SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
