**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for Roll-off Containers for use during the Village's Annual Cleanup program; and


**WHEREAS**, the attached bids were opened and the lowest responsible bidder identified; and

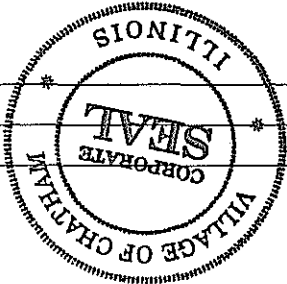
**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.

This correspondence constitutes a proposal from Waste Management to provide services for the 2002 Chatham Fall Cleanup scheduled for September 23 –October 4, 2002.

Equipment Supplied:

Six (6) 20 yd<sup>3</sup> Roll-off Containers

Schedule of Service:

Waste Management will deliver (6) Roll-off Containers on Monday, September 16 to the Chatham maintenance building.

Waste Management will provide an on-site roll-off driver to work with the crew daily to empty roll-offs as needed.

Charges for Service:

20 yd<sup>3</sup> Container    Delivery, Return, and Disposal (up to 7 tons)        \$235

Please note that the 20 yd<sup>3</sup> Containers have a maximum capacity of 7 ton. There will be a \$31 charge per ton over the maximum capacity of 7 ton.

To allow for safe transport on the roadways, all containers must be tarped. Therefore, the Roll-off Containers can only be filled level full to the top of the container. Any additional material will have to be removed and disposed of by the Village.

Please be aware that the following materials are unacceptable for disposal at the landfill, and therefore **will not be accepted** at the cleanup site: tires, appliances, yard waste, liquid waste (including used oil), lead-acid batteries, and special/hazardous wastes.

Mullin's Salvage of Mt. Olive, IL will provide a 45 foot trailer for appliances and metal. The trailer will be placed at the Chatham maintenance building. This service will be provided free of charge with a minimum of 4 tons of appliances received.

Thank you for the opportunity to bid on your disposal service needs for the annual Chatham clean up. The bid is as follows:

20 yard Roll Off containers - \$290.00 per dump

Appliances need to be kept separate in their own container – NO appliances that contained Freon at any time will be allowed. Since no dumping fees will be incurred on appliance containers these will be hauled for \$55.00 per dump

Mattresses and Box Springs will be hauled with a stipulation that if the "transfer station" owned and operated by Waste Management charges us extra fees, that fee will in turn be passed on to the Village of Chatham.

The following items will not be hauled: No Railroad Ties, Telephone Poles, Tires, Yardwaste, Liquid Paint or Chemicals,
