

ORDINANCE 02-48

AN ORDINANCE IN REFERENCE TO VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT - POLICE

WHEREAS, the Police Department posted a position of Dispatcher on the department bulletin board and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is recommending as the preferred candidate the appointment of Randall D. Boston, who has prior experience as a Telecommunicator, and has experience with department software.

WHEREAS, current employee, Patricia A. Brown, has given her letter of resignation with an effective date of November 15, 2002.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Randall D. Boston shall be employed as a Telecommunicator on a full-time basis to be paid \$10.783 per hour based on the current Union Contract distributed from the Electric, General and Water funds.


SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.

ADOPTED this 26th day of November, A.D., 2002 pursuant to a roll call vote as follows:


