

Ordinance No. 04- 41

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUMBER OF LIQUOR LICENSES TO  
BE ISSUED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM AND AMENDING THE  
VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY; ILLINOIS, AS  
FOLLOWS:*


**SECTION 1:** Section 111.17(I) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village  
of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

(I) The number of licenses issued by the Village shall be as follows:

- (1) There may be five Class C licenses;
- (2) There may be one Class G license;
- (3) There may be one Class N license;
- (4) There may be two Class P licenses;
- (5) There may be two Class R -1 license;
- (6) There maybe no Class R-2licenses;
- (7) There may be one Class SE license outstanding at any time;
- (8) There may be three Class T licenses.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.  
The Clerk shall see to the inclusion of this ordinance in the next published update  
of the Village Code of Ordinances


