AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A
BID FOR LEAF BAGS

WHEREAS; the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for 35,000 biodegradable paper yard waste bags; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2006 at 1:00 p.m. the bids were opened and the lowest responsible bidder identified. The staff has reviewed said bids and is recommending the lowest bid from Lowes for \$10,500.00 or \$.30 per bag.

The Village of Chatham reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid that best serves the purpose of this program. For any information, please call Meredith Branham at 217-483-4715.


