4. The undersigned further declares that he has carefully examined the Proposal, Plans, Specifications and the Special Provisions, and that he has inspected in detail the site of the proposed Work, and that he has familiarized himself with all of the local conditions affecting the Contract and the detailed requirements of construction, and understands that in making this Proposal he waives all right to plead any misunderstanding regarding the same.
5. The undersigned agrees to complete the construction within sixty (60) calendar days or by June 15, 2007.

(2) Any singular reference to Bidder, Surety, Owner or other party shall be considered plural where applicable.

1. Bidder and Surety, jointly and severally, bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to pay to Owner upon default of Bidder the penal sum set forth on the face of this Bond.
2. Default of Bidder shall occur upon the failure of Bidder to deliver within the time required by the Bidding Documents the executed Agreement required by the Bidding Documents and any performance and payment bonds required by the Bidding Documents and Contract Documents.
3. This obligation shall be null and void if:
 - 3.1 Owner accepts Bidder's bid and Bidder delivers within the time required by the Bidding Documents (or any extension thereof agreed to in writing by Owner) the executed Agreement required by the Bidding Documents and any performance and payment bonds required by the Bidding Documents and Contract Documents, or
 - 3.2 All bids are rejected by Owner, or
 - 3.3 Owner fails to issue a notice of award to Bidder within the time specified in the Bidding Documents (or any extension thereof agreed to in writing by Bidder and, if applicable, consented to by Surety when required by paragraph 5 hereof).
4. Payment under this Bond will be due and payable upon default of bidder and within 30 calendar days after receipt by Bidder and Surety of written notice of default from Owner, which notice will be given with reasonable promptness, identifying this Bond and the Project and including a statement of the amount due.
5. Surety waives notice of and any and all defenses based on or arising out of any time extension to issue notice of award agreed to in writing by Owner and Bidder, provided that the time for issuing notice of award including extensions shall not in the aggregate exceed 120 days from Bid Due Date without Surety's written consent.
6. No suit or action shall be commenced under this Bond prior to 30 calendar days after the notice of default required in paragraph 4 above is received by Bidder and Surety, and in no case later than one year after Bid Due Date.
7. Any suit or action under this Bond shall be commenced only in a court of competent jurisdiction located in the state in which the Project is located.
8. Notice required hereunder shall be in writing and sent to Bidder and Surety at their respective addresses shown on the face of this Bond. Such notices may be sent by personal delivery, commercial courier or by United States Registered or Certified Mail, return receipt requested, postage pre-paid, and shall be deemed to be effective upon receipt by the party concerned.
9. Surety shall cause to be attached to the Bond a current and effective Power of Attorney evidencing the authority of the officer, agent or representative who executed this Bond on behalf of Surety to execute, seal and deliver such Bond and bind the Surety thereby.
10. This Bond is intended to conform to all applicable statutory requirements. Any applicable requirement of any applicable statute that has been omitted from this Bond shall be deemed to be included herein as if set forth at length. If any provision of the Bond conflicts with any applicable provision of any applicable statute, then the provision of said statute shall govern and the remainder of this Bond that is not in conflict therewith shall continue in full force and effect.
11. The term "bid" as used herein includes a bid, offer or proposal as applicable.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. PROJECT SITE

All work will be done along Mansion Road and abandoned lane at Route 4 and a farm field.

2. TIME FOR COMPLETION

The Work which the Contractor is required to perform under this Contract shall be commenced at the time stipulated by the Village of Chatham and shall be fully completed within sixty (60) consecutive calendar days thereafter. **It is expected that the work will be clear from IEPA to proceed by mid April.**

3. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor agrees to complete the construction within sixty (60) calendar days or by June 15, 2007.

4. CONTRACTOR'S AND SUBCONTRACTOR'S PUBLIC LIABILITY, VEHICLE LIABILITY, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE

As required under Section 7-2 of the Standard Specifications, the Contractor's Public Liability insurance and Vehicle Liability Insurance shall be in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 for injuries, including accidental death, to any one person, and subject to the same limit for each person, in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 on account of one accident, and Contractor's Property Damage Insurance in an amount not less than \$500,000.

The Contractor shall either (1) require each of his subcontractors to procure and to maintain during the life of his subcontract, Subcontractor's Public Liability and Property Damage of the type and in the same amounts as specified in the preceding paragraph, or (2) insure the activities of his subcontractors in his own policy.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR

Except as otherwise specifically stated in the Contract Documents and Technical Specifications, the Contractor shall provide and pay for all materials, labor, tools, equipment, water, light, heat, power, transportation, superintendence, temporary construction of every nature, charges, levies, fee or other expenses and all other services and facilities of every nature whatsoever necessary for the performance of the Contract and to deliver all improvements embraced in this Contract complete in every respect within the specified time.

6. LUMP SUM ITEMS

It is the intent of these specifications that payment under the lump sum items as set forth in the Proposal shall include all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the drawings, and as herein specified. No additional payment will be made for construction of the work shown and specified. The Owner reserves the right to delete particular items from the work at any time before or after the Contract is awarded without affecting the other items.

7. SCOPE OF WORK

The work under this Contract shall include the following major items:

1,500 lineal feet of 10" sewer to serve Prairie Vista and future retail area sites along Route 4.

8. UNIT PRICE ITEMS

It is the intent of these specifications that payment under the unit price items as set forth in the Proposal shall include all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the drawings, and as herein specified. No additional payment will be made for construction of the work shown and specified. The Owner reserves the right to delete particular items from the work at any time before or after the Contract is awarded without affecting the other items.

9. CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE

The work shall be started within 10 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed, and the work shall be executed with such progress as required to prevent any delay to the general completion of the project. The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer, a Construction Schedule showing the order of the work, the time for starting each item, and the approximate time for construction of each item.

10. CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIVE

The Contractor shall designate an authorized representative who shall be responsible for production and who shall assume responsibility for reviewing progress of the work with the Engineer. The Contractor's representative shall have direct control and complete authority to act on behalf of the Contractor, and such authority shall not be interrupted throughout the duration of the Contract, without approval of the Engineer.

11. RECORD DRAWINGS

Record documents (As-Builts) are those Drawings and Specifications maintained and annotated by the Contractor during construction to record approved options and deviations from Contract Documents. For record purposes, the engineer will furnish the Contractor with one set of Contract Drawings (black line prints), and one set of Contract Specifications.

Upon completion of the work, the Contractor shall furnish the Engineer with a marked-up set of blackline prints and specifications on which all options and deviations and pertinent field notes are clearly marked.

12. SPRINGFIELD METRO SANITARY DISTRICT PERMIT WORK

The successful awarded Contractor must or will be approved by the Springfield Metro Sanitary District.

13. CONTRACTOR QUALITY CONTROL

The Contractor shall establish a quality control system to perform sufficient inspection and tests of all items of work including that of subcontractors, to ensure conformance to applicable specifications and drawings with respect to the materials, workmanship, construction, finish, functional performance, and identification. This control shall be established for all construction.

14. STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

Work under this contract shall be performed in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Main Construction in Illinois, Fifth Edition, Adopted May 1996, unless otherwise noted.

Other standard specifications and codes utilized under this contract are as follows:

- A. Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction Adopted January 1, 2007 by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), including all addenda.
- B. Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions Adopted January 1, 2007 by IDOT.
- C. Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, latest edition.
- D. Standard Specifications for Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Adopted October 1987 by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA).
- E. Illinois State Plumbing Code, latest edition.
- F. Springfield Metro Sanitary District rules and regulations.

General Specifications and Special Provisions supplement the Standard Specifications and Codes. In case of a conflict, the Special Provisions shall take precedence and govern.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Main Construction in Illinois" Fifth Edition, dated May 1996, the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted January 1, 2007 by the Illinois Department of Transportation, the latest edition of the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", in effect on the date of the Advertisement for Bids, the "Standard Specifications for Traffic Control Items", by the Illinois Department of Transportation, in effect on the date of the Advertisement for Bids, and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions", adopted January 1, 2007 by the Illinois Department of Transportation, and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said specifications, these Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

1. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work under this contract consists of the construction of 1,500 lineal feet of 10" sewer to serve serve Prairie Vista and future retail area sites along Route 4.

2. PROPERTY MARKERS, SURVEY MARKERS OR MONUMENTS

The Contractor's attention is called to the property markers, survey markers, monuments, and section markers throughout the project. The marker or monuments shall be protected in accordance with Article 107.20 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

3. COOPERATION WITH UTILITIES

The Contractor shall notify all utility companies in the area to aid in locating their underground services. In the event of a break in an existing watermain, gas main, sewer or underground cable, he shall immediately notify the responsible official of the organization operating the utility interrupted. The Contractor shall lend all possible assistance in restoring services and shall assume all costs, charges, or claims connected with the interruption and repair of such services if the locations of said utility were marked by the utility prior to excavation.

4. J.U.L.I.E. SYSTEM

The toll free number for Joint Utility Locations Information for Excavators is 1-800-892-0123.

5. CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE

The Contractor shall provide insurance as required by Section 7-2 of the Standard Specifications and Umbrella Coverage in the amount of \$2,000,000. The Contractor shall furnish the following entities a Certificate (or certificates) of Insurance* when the signed Contract is returned to the Owner for execution, and shall maintain the insurance at all times during the performance of this Contract.

*Each Certificate shall state that the Owner and Engineer shall be given ten (10) days prior notice in the event of cancellation of the policy. The certificates of insurance must name the following as "additional insured". They are: The Village of Chatham and Greene & Bradford, Inc.

6. ADDITIONAL DEPTH MANHOLE

This item of work shall be completed in accordance with Section 32 -"Manholes for Storm and Sanitary Sewers" of the Standard Specifications. Additional depth manhole sections shall be precast. Payment shall be made at the Contract Unit Price bid for **Manhole – EACH** and no additional charge for additional depth.

7. 8", 10" & 15" SANITARY SEWERS, VARIOUS DEPTHS (PVC)

This item of work shall be completed in accordance with Section 31 -"Pipe Laying, Jointing and Testing" of the Standard Specifications. All testing required for this pipe shall be considered incidental to this item. Payment shall be made at the Contract Unit Price bid for **(Size) Sanitary Sewer (All Depths) - Linear Foot.**

8. CONSTRUCTION WITHIN FARM FIELDS

All work within farm field shall be constructed within the temporary easement as noted on the Plans. The Village shall reimburse the tenants for crop damages within this distance. **Any damage beyond this will be at the Contractor's expense and deducted from the contract at \$1,000 per acre.**

9. TREE AND BRUSH REMOVAL

The Contractor will remove the minimum required trees and burn Wednesday through Saturday when prevailing wind conditions permit.

10. SEEDING AND MULCHING

There will be no seeding required as the farmer will be farming this area after construction.

11. PREVAILING WAGES

The prevailing rate of wages to be paid by the Contractor and all Subcontractors are attached on the next page. Not less than the minimum wages as set forth by the attached sheet must be paid on this project. Proof of compliance must be presented if requested.

Explanations

SANGAMON COUNTY

The following list is considered as those days for which holiday rates of wages for work performed apply: New Years Day, Memorial/Decoration Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. Generally, any of these holidays which fall on a Sunday is celebrated on the following Monday. This then makes work performed on that Monday payable at the appropriate overtime rate for holiday pay. Common practice in a given local may alter certain days of celebration such as the day after Thanksgiving for Veterans Day. If in doubt, please check with IDOL.

Oil and chip resealing (O&C) means the application of road oils and liquid asphalt to coat an existing road surface, followed by application of aggregate chips or gravel to coated surface, and subsequent rolling of material to seal the surface.

EXPLANATION OF CLASSES

ASBESTOS - GENERAL - removal of asbestos material/mold and hazardous materials from any place in a building, including mechanical systems where those mechanical systems are to be removed. This includes the removal of asbestos materials/mold and hazardous materials from ductwork or pipes in a building when the building is to be demolished at the time or at some close future date.

ASBESTOS - MECHANICAL - removal of asbestos material from mechanical systems, such as pipes, ducts, and boilers, where the mechanical systems are to remain.

CERAMIC TILE FINISHER, MARBLE FINISHER, TERRAZZO FINISHER

Assisting, helping or supporting the tile, marble and terrazzo mechanic by performing their historic and traditional work assignments required to complete the proper installation of the work covered by said crafts. The term "Ceramic" is used for naming the classification only and is in no way a limitation of the product handled. Ceramic

takes into consideration most hard tiles.

ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN

Installation, service and maintenance of low-voltage systems which utilizes the transmission and/or transference of voice, sound, vision, or digital for commercial, education, security and entertainment purposes for the following: TV monitoring and surveillance, background/foreground music, intercom and telephone interconnect, field programming, inventory control systems, microwave transmission, multi-media, multiplex, radio page, school, intercom and sound burglar alarms and low voltage master clock systems.

Excluded from this classification are energy management systems, life safety systems, supervisory controls and data acquisition systems not intrinsic with the above listed systems, fire alarm systems, nurse call systems and raceways exceeding fifteen feet in length.

TRUCK DRIVER - BUILDING, HEAVY AND HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

Class 1. Drivers on 2 axle trucks hauling less than 9 ton. Air compressor and welding machines and brooms, including those pulled by separate units, truck driver helpers, warehouse employees, mechanic helpers, greasers and tiremen, pickup trucks when hauling materials, tools, or workers to and from and on-the-job site, and fork lifts up to 6,000 lb. capacity.

Class 2. Two or three axle trucks hauling more than 9 ton but hauling less than 16 ton. A-frame winch trucks, hydrolift trucks, vector trucks or similar equipment when used for transportation purposes. Fork lifts over 6,000 lb. capacity, winch trucks, four axle combination units, and ticket writers.

Class 3. Two, three or four axle trucks hauling 16 ton or more. Drivers on water pulls, articulated dump trucks, mechanics and working forepersons, and dispatchers. Five axle or more combination units.

Class 4. Low Boy and Oil Distributors.

Class 5. Drivers who require special protective clothing while employed on hazardous waste work.

TRUCK DRIVER - OIL AND CHIP RESEALING ONLY.

This shall encompass laborers, workers and mechanics who drive contractor or subcontractor owned, leased, or hired pickup, dump, service, or oil distributor trucks. The work includes transporting materials and equipment (including but not limited to, oils, aggregate supplies, parts, machinery and tools) to or from the job site; distributing oil or liquid asphalt and aggregate; stock piling material when in connection with the actual oil and chip contract. The Truck Driver (Oil & Chip Resealing) wage classification does not include supplier delivered materials.

Other Classifications of Work:

For definitions of classifications not otherwise set out, the Department generally has on file such definitions which are available. If a task to be performed is not subject to one of the classifications of pay set out, the Department will upon being contacted state which neighboring county has such a classification and provide such rate, such rate being deemed to exist by reference in this document. If no neighboring county rate applies to the task, the Department shall undertake a special determination, such special determination being then deemed to have existed under this determination. If a project requires these, or any classification not listed, please contact IDOL at 618/993-7271 for wage rates or clarifications.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping work falls under the existing classifications for laborer, operating engineer and truck driver. The work performed by landscape plantsman and landscape laborer is covered by the existing classification of laborer. The work performed by landscape operators (regardless of equipment used or its size) is covered by the classifications of operating engineer. The work performed by landscape truck drivers (regardless of size of truck driven) is covered by the classifications of truck driver.

CONTRACT

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements mentioned in the Proposal hereto attached, to be made and performed by the OWNER, and according to the terms expressed in the Bond referring to these presents, the CONTRACTOR agrees with OWNER his/their/its own proper cost and expense to do all the WORK and to furnish all materials and all labor necessary to complete the WORK in accordance with the Plans and Specifications hereinafter described and in full compliance with all the plans of this CONTRACT and the requirements of the ENGINEER under it.

3. And it is also understood and agreed that the Advertisement of Bids, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, Special Provisions, Proposal and Performance and Payment Bond hereto attached, and the Plans and Specifications for VILLAGE OF CHATHAM – NORTH FOX CREEK TRUNK SEWER and all other documents attached hereto are all essential documents of this CONTRACT and are incorporated herein by reference.

4. CONTRACTOR shall maintain, at all times, at his/her/its sole expense, the types and amounts of insurance as set forth in the Special Provisions.

5. Prior to commencement of any work hereunder, CONTRACTOR shall furnish OWNER with Certificates of Insurance showing the type, amount, class of operations covered, effective dates and date of expiration of policies. Such certificates shall show (client's name), its elected and appointed officers, agents, employees, (Mayor and Village Board) and Greene and Bradford, Inc." as additional named insureds. Such certificates shall also contain the following statement: "The insurance covered by this certificate shall not be canceled or altered, except after at least ten (10) days written notice has been received by OWNER." All such insurance shall be "occurrence type" policies and shall not be "claims made" policies. Such Certificate shall indicate an effective date for at least the period of time covered by this Contract.

6. CONTRACTOR shall either 1) require each of its subcontractors to procure and maintain for the same period of time, Subcontractor's Public Liability, Vehicle Liability, Property Damage, and Worker's Compensation insurance of the type and in the same amounts and subject to the same requirements as set forth in the preceding paragraph, or 2) insure the activities of its subcontractors in its own policies.

7. 8. Prior to any payment hereunder, CONTRACTOR shall furnish to OWNER all mechanic's lien waivers for all work, materials, apparatus, fixtures, machinery or labor furnished under this contract.

9. Prior to commencement of any work hereunder, CONTRACTOR shall furnish a signed Performance and Payment Bond in accordance with 30 ILCS 550/1 and 550/2 (1994 State Bar Edition).
10. CONTRACTOR guarantees all work performed and materials provided under this Contract for a period of two years from the date of acceptance by the OWNER and in the event any faulty materials or workmanship are found within this period, CONTRACTOR, at CONTRACTOR's sole expense, shall replace such materials and place in a satisfactory condition all such work when notified by the OWNER, all without expense to the OWNER.
11. CONTRACTOR hereby represents, warrants, and agrees that CONTRACTOR is an independent Contractor hereunder and neither it nor its employees or agents or subcontractors engaged in performing this Contract shall at any time during the performance hereof become employees or agent or subcontractors of the OWNER.
12. CONTRACTOR agrees that all his employees assigned to this particular work shall be paid fringe benefits and at the wage scale for each particular class of employment as is required by OWNER's Prevailing Wage Ordinance; and CONTRACTOR agrees to and shall fully comply with the provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/1 (1994 State Bar Edition). CONTRACTOR shall furnish to the OWNER proof of such compliance upon request of the OWNER, from time to time. CONTRACTOR shall not be entitle to any payment of funds under this Contract until such proof of compliance has been furnished OWNER.
13. CONTRACTOR agrees to and shall fully comply with the Illinois Fair Employment Practices Act and the Fair Employment Practices Commission's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts; and wit the Equal Employment Opportunity Clause attached hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of the CONTRACTOR's noncompliance with such provisions, the CONTRACTOR may be declared nonresponsible and therefore ineligible for future contracts or sub-contracts with the OWNER, the State of Illinois, or any of its political subdivisions or municipal corporations, and this Contract may be canceled or voided in whole or in part, and such other sanctions or penalties may be imposed or remedies invoked as provided by statute or regulation.
14. CONTRACTOR shall also comply with the Discrimination in Public Contracts Act, 775 ILCS 10/1 et. seq. (1994 State Bar Edition) and the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 et. seq. (1994 State Bar Edition) and the Preference to Citizens on Public Work Projects, 30 ILCS 560/1 et. seq. and the Veteran's Preference Act, 330 ILCS 55/1 et. seq. Upon completion of the work to the satisfaction of the OWNER and if so completed in compliance with the terms and provisions of this CONTRACT, OWNER shall pay CONTRACTOR the amount(s) due as reflected in CONTRACTORS bid proposal to the extent accepted by OWNER and as may be later modified by the mutual agreement of OWNER and CONTRACTOR; such payment(s) to be made at the times and in accordance with the terms and provisions not inconsistent herewith as is set forth in the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction prepared by the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois and adopted by said Department on January 1, 2007.
