AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A BID FOR MATERIAL ON WATER MAIN PROJECT AT PARK/WALNUT

WHEREAS, the Village advertised and obtained bids for the replacement of the twelve inch water main on Walnut Street from the west end of Willow Glen Subdivision to Park Avenue, approximately 2900 feet, with 1500 feet an eighteen inch and 1400 feet of twelve inch; with the existing twelve and six inch main to be abandoned; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee met to review the bids and is recommending the lowest bid from HD Supply Water Works for \$79,487.61.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the bid from HD Supply Water Works for \$79,487.61 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The Director is hereby directed to complete the necessary documents at the appropriate timing.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
