WHEREAS, on March 17, 2009 the Public Properties Committee reviewed the bids and is recommending the bid from Terry Brown for \$9,500 for the year.

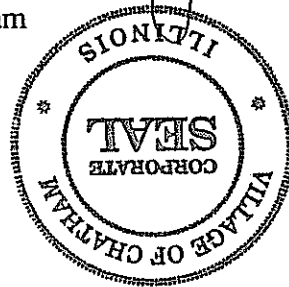
