**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for Roll-off Containers for use during the Village's Annual Cleanup program October 13<sup>th</sup> and October 20<sup>th</sup>; and


**WHEREAS**, the attached bids were opened September 18, 2012 at 1:00 p.m. and the lowest responsible bidder identified; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has reviewed the bids and is recommending the acceptance of the bid from Waste Management.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** That the bid from Waste Management for \$295.00 per loaded 30 yard container, and no charge for the 30 yard Scrap Metal Container. Excluded items include but not limited to; appliances containing freon, fuel tanks, rail road ties, yard waste, liquids of any type, tires, landscape waste, batteries , hazardous material, televisions, computers, printers, monitors, fax machines, servers, modems, phones, music players, stereos, video recording devices.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.

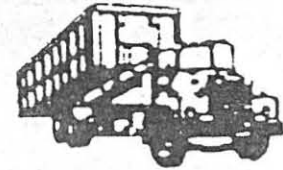

Subject: Dumpster Bid

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**We bid:**

\$300.00 per 30 yard load of waste, \$250.00 per 25 yard load of waste, and \$200 per 20 yard load of waste. Dumpsters will also be provided and hauled by us, free of charge for Appliances (not containing freon) and other Metal items, which will be recycled. Prices are all inclusive, no other charges will be applied. A credit may be applied for scrap metal sales, depending upon commodity prices at the time of unloading. 30 yard containers will primarily be the size used, but 25 and 20 yards may be used as well.

Excluded or Unacceptable items: appliances with freon, car tires, fuel tanks, liquids, gas, oil, car batteries, chemicals, hazardous materials, landscape wastes (trees, brush, grass, leaves, plants), large amounts of concrete, brick, rock, or dirt.

Since January 1, 2012, Electronic Waste Items have been banned from Landfills by the I.E.P.A. We aren't able to accept the following items in waste loads. TVs, computers, printers, monitors, fax machines, servers, modems, phones, music players, stereos, VCRs, CD/DVD players, etc.

**Option:**

For a flat, all inclusive \$1,800.00, we will hire and assist an Electronics Recycler to be at the Event on both Saturday mornings to accept all of the Electronic Waste items mentioned above. We have found that excluding these items, from cleanup events, upsets the public greatly, as all households have E waste items to discard. We strongly urge you to include this as part of your clean up event, as the negative reaction from people with these items rejected, will reflect poorly upon us.

Prohibited materials include: yard waste, white goods, 55 gallon drums, lead batteries, whole tires, all consumer electronics prohibited by Illinois State Law (P.A. 97-0287). A list can be provided to the Village upon request.

40 yard dumpster(s) for scrap metal.  
Scrap metal to be disposed at Ley Metals\*.  
\*Village of Chatham to receive market rate rebate on metal recovered from Ley Metals.
