**AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER AND SEWER FURNISHED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES**

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS. AS FOLLOWS:*

**SECTION 1:** Section 51.018 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

(A) (1) The following shall be the rates for water supplies through the waterworks system of the Village of Chatham, payable monthly within 15 days after rendition of each bill.

Minimum 0 - 2,000 gal/month	\$23.52	\$29.45
All Usage over 2,000 gal/month	\$ 6.87 per 1000 gal	\$10.34 per 1000 gal
Facility Charge	\$ 8.76 per month	\$ 8.76 per month
Bulk Water	\$ 6.87 per 1000 gal	

Effective September 1, 2013

Minimum 0 - 2,000 gal/month	\$24.38	\$30.55
All Usage over 2,000 gal/month	\$ 7.10 per 1000 gal	\$10.72 per 1000 gal
Facility Charge	\$ 9.11 per month	\$ 9.11 per month
Bulk Water	\$ 7.10 per 1000 gal	


Effective May 1, 2014

(2) A separate charge shall be made for each apartment, place of business or dwelling unit in all buildings containing two or more apartments, places of business, or family units; however, no minimum charge shall be made for any vacant apartment, place of business or dwelling unit which is vacant during an entire month, provided the Water Department has been notified in writing of such vacancy.

(B) In addition to the foregoing rates, there shall be charged to the Fire Protection District, the sum of \$22.65 per year for each fire hydrant connected to the waterworks system for fire protection. This charge may be waived at the discretion of the Village President.

**SECTION 2:** Section 51.020 of the Code of Ordinances is repealed.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval as provided by law. The Clerk shall forthwith publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, and shall see to its inclusion in the next annual update of the Village of Chatham.
