AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF BACKHOE LOADER

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for the purchase of a Backhoe Loaders; and

WHEREAS, the Village appropriated sufficient funds in the annual Appropriation Ordinance to purchase the equipment bid in the Water Fund, and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2014 a Committee of the Village Board met to review the bids and is recommending acceptance of the bid from Altorfer Inc. for the amount of \$71,291.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the bid from Altorfer Inc. for a total of \$71,291.00 is hereby approved, to be paid from the Sewer & Water Fund.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
