AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A QUOTE FOR ROLL-OFF  
CONTAINERS FOR VILLAGE CLEANUP

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham sought and obtained a quote for Roll-off Containers for use during the Village's Annual Cleanup program October 11<sup>th</sup> and October 18<sup>th</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, the attached **quotes** were opened and the lowest responsible bidder identified; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has reviewed the quotes and is recommending the acceptance of the quote from Waste Management.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** That the quote from Waste Management for \$325 per loaded 30 yard container, and no charge for the 30 yard Scrap Metal Container. Excluded items include but not limited to; tires, liquid paint, yard waste, vehicle batteries, appliances containing freon.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
