AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A
BID FOR LEAF BAGS

WHEREAS; the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for 40,000 biodegradable paper yard waste bags a minimum of 30 gallons; and

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. the bids were opened and the lowest qualified bidder identified. The staff has reviewed said bids and is recommending the lowest bid from Lowes of \$.34 per bag.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the bid from Lowes is hereby accepted.

Section 2: That the appropriate officials be and are hereby directed to sign the necessary forms and issue payment upon demand.

The Village of Chatham will accept bids for Yard Waste bags until 1:00 p.m. on Monday September 2, 2014 at which time all bids will be opened and read aloud. Bids shall be placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked {Yard Waste Bag Bid}. Bids should be mailed or hand delivered to 117 E. Mulberry Chatham, IL. 62629.

These Yard Waste bags will be used in the Village of Chatham Leaf Collection program and must be delivered to the Village of Chatham on or before October 3, 2014. The Yard Waste bags must be made of paper type material and is a minimum size of 30 gallons. The initial order will be 3600 bags with the capability of re-ordering 1,800 bags at a time until December 1, 2014. An additional order of 27000 bags will be placed in February. Please include in your bid all information on ordering and time lines for delivery. Please give all information that you wish to be considered in your bid.
