ORDINANCE NO. 42

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A
2016 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SEDAN AWD**

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to purchase a 2016 Interceptor Sedan AWD to be utilized by the Village Police Department, based off the Illinois joint purchasing list, at an amount of \$31,195.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Authority to Purchase Vehicle. The Village President is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate the purchase of a 2016 Interceptor Sedan AWD to be utilized by the Village Police Department, from the Illinois joint purchasing program at an amount of \$31,195.00.

Section 3. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full


force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
