ORDINANCE NO. 19- 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE ON THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR LIQUOR LICENSE HOLDERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter, the "Village"), an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, sets forth the rights of municipalities to govern and restrict the sale of alcoholic liquor within their communities; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2 of the Act provides that the Village has the authority to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses, for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor, not inconsistent with the Act, and the amount of local licensee fees to be paid for the various kinds of licenses to be issues; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to modify the number of R-2 licenses as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.
- Section 2. <u>Amendment to Title XI.</u> The provisions of Title XI, Chapter 111, Section 111.13(A) in the Village Code shall be amended as follows:

111.13 RESTRICTIONS ON LICENSES

No liquor license shall be issued to:

(A) A natural person who is not a resident of the village; A person who is not a resident of the Village or, if a corporation, which does not employ a resident manager who resides within Sangamon County;

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. <u>Effectiveness</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
