ORDINANCE NO. 19-15

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS ON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO
MODIFY AND ADD A THIRD R-2G LICENSE WITHIN THE VILLAGE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter, the "Village"), an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, sets forth the rights of municipalities to govern and restrict the sale of alcoholic liquor within their communities; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2 of the Act provides that the Village has the authority to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses, for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor, not inconsistent with the Act, and the amount of local licensee fees to be paid for the various kinds of licenses to be issues; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to modify the number of R-2G licenses as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Amendment to Chapter 111. Section 111.17A(L)(13), in Chapter 111, Title XI, shall be amended as follows:

(13) There may be ~~two~~ three Class R-2G licenses;

Section 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall

not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effectiveness. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
