**ORDINANCE NO. 19-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS ON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO AUTHORIZE THE LIQUOR COMMISSIONER TO ISSUE LIMITED EXTENSION OF HOUR PERMITS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter, the “Village”), an Illinois municipal corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, sets forth the rights of municipalities to govern and restrict the sale of alcoholic liquor within their communities; and

**WHEREAS**, from time-to-time, license holders hold events wherein it would be appropriate to extend the time for service of alcoholic liquor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to modify Village Code to give the Liquor Commissioner the ability to allow license holders to extend the time for service of alcoholic liquor on a limited basis.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.**     Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

**Section 2.**     Amendment to Chapter 111. Section 111.22(A)(6), in Chapter 111, Title XI, shall be amended as follows:

- (6)     In addition, the holder of any license, regardless of classification, shall be permitted to sell or offer for sale at retail alcoholic liquor in the village from the closing time established above for December 31 until the hour of 1:00 a.m. on January 1 in any year, ~~and~~ until 1:00 a.m. on Thanksgiving Day, and as allowed by special permit issued under Section 111.50(B)(8).

**Section 3.** Amendment to Chapter 111. Section 111.50 in Chapter 111, Title XI, shall be amended by adding a new subsection (8) to Section 11.50(B) as follows:

(8) To grant a permit to the holder of any license, regardless of classification, to extend their hours of business to 1:00 a.m. for specific events, but no more than three (3) times per year per licensee. Such a request must be made in writing no less than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the event. No permit shall be granted unless it is tied to an event associated with a nationally recognized holiday or a community-wide event.

**Section 4.** Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.


**Section 5.** Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 6.** Effectiveness. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
