ORDINANCE NO. 19- 22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES FOR THE VILLAGE MANAGER AND CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (“Village”), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 35.06 of the Village Code provides the Board shall annually establish the salaries of the Village Manager and Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the annual appropriation ordinance adopted by the Village Board permitted a 3% increase in the existing salaries of the Village Manager and Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires formally to set the salaries of the Village Manager and Chief of Police as set forth in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to raise the salaries of the Village Manager and Chief of Police, in line with other employee salaries of the Village, by 3%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval of Salaries. For the Fiscal Year 2019/2020, the salary of the Village Manager shall be \$112,980.00 and the salary of the Chief of Police shall be \$106,358.00. Retroactive payments shall be made to reflect the 3% increase effective May 1, 2019.

Section 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest

extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
