ORDINANCE NO. 20-6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN ITEMS OF VILLAGE PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter, the “Village”), an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, grants municipalities, with a population less than 500,000, the authority to sell and dispose of personal property it determines, by a simple majority of the corporate authorities, to be no longer useful and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that the personal property currently housed by the Village and outlined in Exhibit A is no longer needed by the Village or useful and should be disposed of based on the provisions of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham find that it is in the best interests of the Village to dispose of the Village property set forth in Exhibit A as outlined in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as if specifically stated in full.

Section 2. Disposition of Property. The Village Chief of Police or his Designee is authorized to sell the property indicated on Exhibit A to a certified police department. If items are

not purchased they may be donated or otherwise disposed of as directed by the Police Chief or his or her designee.

Section 3. Repeal & Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
