

RESOLUTION NO. 7-79

Whereas, the PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, in its regular meeting of June 14, 1977 enacted Ordinance No. 77-16 regulating the use of the Chatham Village Park; and

Whereas, that Ordinance provided in Section 5 that this PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM may by formal action grant specific exception in in the best interest of the resident of the Village of Chatham;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS.

That the PRESIDENT AND BORAD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM has considered the application of THE AMERICAN LEGION for the use of the Chatham Village Park during the following period of time: June 28, 29, and 30 1979, and has concluded that such use would be in the best interest of the resident of the Village of Chatham; and

That the provisions of Ordinance No. 77-16 referred to above, shall not apply to above, shall not apply to use for the period specifically described above.
