A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO HALLOWEEN OBSERVANCE


WHEREAS, the observance of Halloween traditions will bring many of the children of Chatham out trick-or-treating; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, want this Halloween to be as safe and as enjoyable as possible for those taking part.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:
