A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 25, 1996 AS
REVEREND MARTIN B. OLSON DAY


WHEREAS, He has been named Pastor Emeritus by the congregation of the Chatham Presbyterian Church.

SECTION 1: That February 25, 1996 is hereby proclaimed Reverend Martin B. Olson Day in Chatham.


SECTION 2: This Resolution is effective immediately.
