BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The appropriate staff and committees of the Village of Chatham are hereby directed to perform required tasks to make changes to the Zoning Ordinance, making Pigmy Goats a special use in residential zones, with special guide lines.

SECTION 2: This resolution is effective upon passage.
