
*A Resolution Granting Ball Chatham Educational Foundation Use Of Public Property*

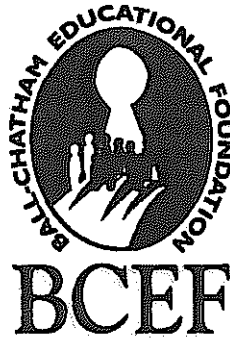

**RE: Fundraising 5km Running Event on November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009**

I am the treasurer for the Ball-Chatham Educational Foundation and am heading up our fall fundraising event. The event is a 5km run on November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The purpose of the fundraiser is to raise money to support technology in the Ball-Chatham school district classrooms (such as the interactive "Active Boards" currently in many classrooms).

The event will be held out of the east side of the Chatham Community Park. The proposed route for the 5km (3.1 mile) run is:

- **START POINT:** east edge of the park, at the beginning of Park Street (heading north)
- North on Park to Spruce Street
- Right on Spruce Street
- Left on Ramblewood to Gordon Drive
- Right on Gordon Drive for short distance
- Right on Spruce Street into Breckenridge Manor
- Quick left onto Grindstone
- Right on Silver Tree
- Left on Spruce Street
- Left on Park Street heading south back towards the start point
- Through the start point and onto the internal park bike/walking path for 0.3 miles
- **END POINT:** inside the park on the path in front of Field #5 (across from main pavilion)

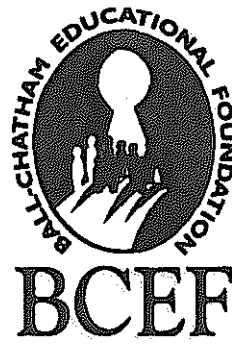
The time line for the run is:

- Registration from 7am to 7:45am
- Run prep from 7:45am to 8am
- Start Time: 8am
- Estimated Completion: 9am
- Awards/Closing: 9am to 10am

**BCEF Board Members and Support Staff for Event: Between 15 and 20**

**Expected Event Attendance/Target Number of Runners: Between 150 and 200**

I have provided a copy of this letter to the Chatham Police Department to inform them of this event for their review and approval of the route. I will also contact the Police Department about a month out from the event to review the route again and coordinate any assistance.


We will have event staff at each mile marker/turn point to direct the runners and also help with traffic control.
