RESOLUTION NO. 22-16

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SEWER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM AS OF AUGUST 1, 2016

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, for sewer service, the Village has adopted a minimum charge and basic user rate per 1,000 gallons of water used; and

WHEREAS, the Village has passed Ordinance 15-27, allowing the Village to set the Sewer Rate by Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village believe it is just and proper to provide prior notice to the public of all rate changes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Rates.

- (a) The Sewer Rates as of August 1, 2016, shall be as follows: (i) Facility Charge of \$11.13 per month; and (ii) Consumption Charge of \$4.52 per 1,000 gallons consumed.
- Section 3. Date Rate Change Goes into Effect. The new rates shall be posted on consumers' bills for the next billing cycle, and rates shall be posted in Village Hall and on the Village website as soon as practicable. The new rates shall go into effect on August 1, 2016.
- **Section 4.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
