

RESOLUTION NO. 38 - 18

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING TRENTON N. THOMPSON AS THE DIRECTOR OF  
THE CHATHAM EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham (“Village”), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Code, Section 92.04, provides the Director of the Chatham Emergency Management Agency (“CEMA”) shall be appointed by the President of the Village with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director shall have a term of office of four years and until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President desires to appoint, and the Village Board desires to confirm the appointment of Trenton N. Thompson as a Director of CEMA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

**Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

**Section 2.** Director Appointment. Trenton N. Thompson is hereby appointed as the Director of the Chatham Emergency Management Agency. In accordance with the Village’s appropriation ordinance, Mr. Thompson shall receive a salary of \$2,666.67 per month and shall be entitled to no other benefits or compensation.


**Section 3.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
