RESOLUTION NO. 47 - 18

A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BIDS FOR THE VILLAGE TREE TRIMMING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village"), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village published and requested bids from qualified contractors to conduct tree trimming for electric distribution line clearance within the Village, along with the easements and rights of way; and

WHEREAS, the Village received three bids and the lowest bid was \$88,590; and

WHEREAS, the low bid exceeds the budgeted amount for tree trimming and accordingly Village staff is recommending all bids be rejected, the project scope narrowed and the services re-bid; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds it to be in the best interests of the Village to reject all of the bids for tree trimming services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

- Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.
- Section 2. Rejection of Bids. The Board of Trustees of the Village hereby reject all bids submitted for tree trimming services within the Village and direct staff to narrow the scope of the project and rebid the services.
- **Section 3.** Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
